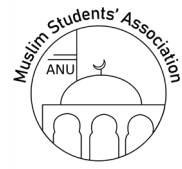
General guidelines:

- No degrading, vulgar, or inflammatory language
- Must not share content or use language which is discriminatory against any individual or group's characteristics including sexual orientation, gender, race, religion, ethnicity, nationality, age, etc... Religious discussions about such topics must be done in a respectful and tolerant manner to educate on authentic religious rulings and matters and within an appropriate setting and context. If these guidelines are broken, the post will be taken down immediately and replaced with an apology, if the post brought harm to a particular individual or group within the community then the apology should be addressed to them directly.
- Photos and videos of members will not be posted online without the consent of those individual members. If any photos are mistakenly posted without that person's consent, they must be removed on time.
- The ANU MSA will not participate in political issues or debates or take any political stance for or against a certain issue. The ANU MSA may provide religious educational information about the political issue or circumstance without addressing it outright or taking a stance. For example, if a Muslim member of the community commits a crime,

the MSA would provide religious evidence and understanding regarding that crime in general without addressing the event or situation itself.

- No commercial advertising.
- The ANU MSA may advertise events or opportunities which are relevant to the Muslim community at ANU however these advertisements must be approved by 2 or more members of the ANU MSA executives in writing (via text/email/etc...)
- Any use of languages other than English must contain English translations, this includes all Islamic greetings and phrases such as Assalam u Alaikum should be translated as peace be upon you.
- The ANU MSA should not share or promote any materials or events which cause sectarianism or which promote or align with a particular sect of Islam. Any religious material and content which is shared must be under the Quran and authentic Hadith, providing proper references.
